Virtual Summer School

Middle School (Grades 6-8)

2021-2022 School Year

Fulton Virtual provides online learning options for middle and high school students throughout the district, enabling greater flexibility for students aiming to recover credit or accelerate classes. Courses are student-driven, and instructor-facilitated; instructors work with students, parents/guardians and other interested parties (e.g., counselors) to deliver course learning objectives and support the academic needs of each student. The offerings of Fulton Virtual provide varied and dynamic content,



user friendly customization and personalization options, as well as opportunities for students at earlier ages to engage in learning virtually.

Summer School is an opportunity for Fulton County middle school students to accelerate or recover courses during the time between school years.

Summer sessions are full content presented in an abbreviated amount of time (i.e. 18 weeks of content in a 6 week period), and students must have their course requests validated by their counselor before being enrolled. For summer 2022, students who have previously failed a course can retake the course for free. Students may take up to two courses* at no cost. Any additional courses will require tuition. All courses taken for the first time will require tuition.

Completion Benchmarks: Students may work at their own pace but must make the required progress in their course by the benchmark dates. Students can work ahead and, if a student is on vacation, they will need to work ahead to remain on target. Students not reaching the completion benchmarks will be administratively dropped from their course. Dropped courses will not appear on transcripts and will not receive a refund of tuition paid. Completion benchmark dates are noted on the Important Dates chart.

Tuition

- 1 Class = \$225 (\$180 with free/reduced meal status) per course
- *Students who need to retake a class may attend summer school provided by Fulton County Schools at no cost up to 2.0 credits (4, 1 semester courses). Additional courses require tuition.

Parents and students request courses through the Fulton Virtual School web page. Once a course request has been created, an email is sent to the student's home school for review by the counseling staff. The review and approval process will take about 2 weeks. If it is accepted, a follow-up email is sent to the parent/student requesting that they log back in to https://myapps.classlink.com/home, log in, click on the Genius-Fulton Virtual Icon to pay for their courses.
